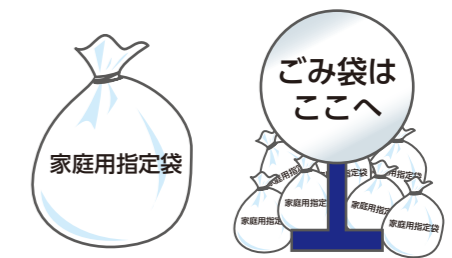
GARBAGE COLLECTION CALENDAR

Take out combustibles in "specified bags for domestic burnable garbage."
Take out recyclables in "transparent bags"

Waste category	How to take out garbage
Combustibles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Kitchen waste and paper waste. •Drain off water from kitchen waste. 
Metals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Empty cans of their contents. •Puncture a hole in spray cans. 
Plastics	With "Pura" mark <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Indicate "マークあり" (With mark) on the garbage bag. •Empty containers of their contents. •Wash out and dry dirty plastics before taking them out. 
	Without "Pura" mark <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Indicate "マークなし" (Without mark) on the garbage bag. •Crush plastics into small pieces to fit in a garbage bag. 
Glass	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Remove the cap/lid from empty glass bottles and crockery. 
Recyclables	Plastic (PET) bottles <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Take out plastic caps and labels of plastic bottles in a garbage bag indicated "マークあり" (With mark). •Wash out and dry plastic bottles before taking them out.

Fluorescent lamps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Please take these items without cracking them. •Fluorescent lamps are not collected as "Glass" waste. •Please take these items to stores that collect these items or a recycle center. *For details, please see our website.
Batteries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Batteries are not collected as "Metal" waste. •Please take these items to designated public facilities, stores that collect these items or a recycle center. *For details, please see our website. 
Used paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Take out used paper waste as recyclables or take them directly to a recycle center. 
Small Home Electronic Appliances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Please take all small home electronic appliances (excluding the four specified categories of electronic appliances) to a recycle center.

Please take oversized waste directly to either center. Some oversized waste may need to be scrapped.












Service hours for direct carry-in

While burnable garbage is collected on national holidays and substitute holidays, it cannot be taken to either facility.

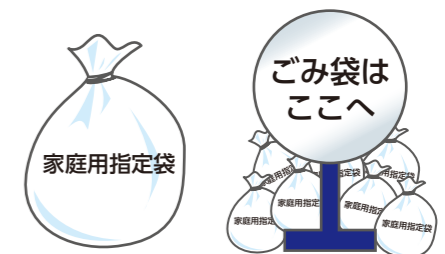

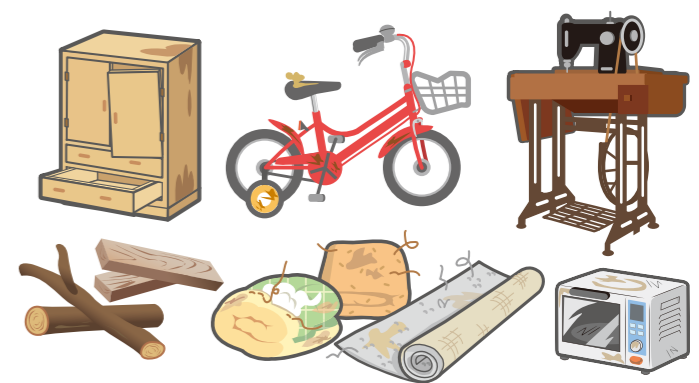
